- Training, knowledge sharing, and development of skills will be provided to everyone to work safely.
- Everyone is empowered to contribute to Safety, Health and Environmental activities and initiatives.
- The effectiveness of our Management System is regularly evaluated by setting transparent goals and targets, and performance monitoring including internal and external audits, and establishing action plans to timely resolve any matter related to Safety, Health and Environment.
